# Basketball Sportsmanship Award Criteria Evaluation Additions & Deductions (Updated 2/2016)

## **Additions**

## One time allowed

Students/fans display sportsmanship like actions toward opponent during introductions

School has made an EXTRA EFFORT for students to attend game

Visible presence and adequate number of supervision in front of students

Positive signs/banners

Proper use of school flags (i.e. does not obstruct view, not waving during live ball)

Band or drumline in attendance and playing at appropriate times throughout entire game

Mascot in attendance and encouraging positive enthusiasm

Immediate response by supervision to address problems

## Max out @ 5 occurrences

Positive chants from student/fan sections

Positive player interaction (i.e. cheering on teammates, helping up opponent when on floor)

Supervision is proactive in response to negative activity by students and adults

Cheerleaders engage student and/or fan sections; halftime performance

Appropriate & creativity of fan sections (i.e. organized, positive chants and appropriate attire themes)

Sportsmanlike conduct or actions by players and coaches (i.e. displays respect toward opponent and officials)

Advancement points (Increases the further a team advances in the tournament)

Schools/Teams/Coaching Staffs are evaluated on the cooperation given to site hosts

Pre-Game: Listening to & following protocol

Teams respecting facilities (locker rooms bench areas

No Major Fan problems

Positive Interaction with Coaching Staff

Post-Game: Cooperation with Team, School and Fans

## **Deductions**

## One time allowed

Disrespect toward opponent during introductions (i.e. turning back, newspapers)

Inadequate number of supervision/not visible in front of students

## Per Occurrence:

Minor Negative chants

Profane gestures from student/fan sections (racial, ethnic, sexual)

Throwing objects towards the competition floor

Chants/demeaning comments directed at a player, coach, official, school, supervisor (students or adults)

Inadequate response by supervision

Negative reaction to officiating by athletes, coaches, students, adults

Inappropriate use of American flag – wearing or draping

Inappropriate signs, banners, or attire, noisemakers, band playing during live ball, no shirts

Inappropriate use of school flags (i.e. during live ball, running up and down the sidelines)

Individuals rushing the floor (small group)

Unsportsmanlike conduct or actions by a player or coach (i.e. technical foul, inappropriate coach or player reaction to officials' call)

Ejection, Flagrant Technical Foul,

Fans rushing floor after game (organized group)
