Considerations When Developing a Game Model

Consideration 1:

- How Many Players on the Field?
- Do you play with offside?
- One ball? Two teams?
- Goals on opposite sides of field?
- Substitutions rules?
- Are you allowed to tie games?
- What happens when you get yellow cards?
- Do injured players have to come off the field?

Consideration 2:

- Games per week?
- Do you make the schedule?
- How many teams total?
- Points awarded based on opponent?
- How do you qualify for playoffs?
- Where has your team finished in the past?
- School or club/team rules and restrictions?
- Do some games matter more than others?
- Reserve/JV teams?

Consideration 3:

- What is the perception of the players, parents, and other contributors?
- How involved are the parents and other contributors?
- Whose opinions do your players value?
 - o club/former coaches, family, friends, etc...
- Players feelings/commitment to the sport?
- Do your players have a Growth or Fixed Mindset?

Consideration 4:

- How knowledgeable are you? What soccer references do you have?
- What are you willing to learn?
- How much time do you have to improve yourself in coaching?
- What other duties do you have?
- How much time do you have for your players?
